#### **Who should attend the course?**

This course is aimed at authors who need to re-purpose FrameMaker into different publishing channels using Quadralay WebWorks Publisher.

**How long is the course?** 2 Days

#### **What are the benefits of attending?**

After introducing the basic concepts and overviewing the templates included in WebWorks Publisher Professional Edition 7.0, this two-day course covers all aspects of converting single-source FrameMaker books into various online formats. The course begins with an explanation of how to properly map and customize styles using the new Style Designer and then shows you how to implement your own corporate look-and-feel via the page templates along with how to create cross-platform and cross-browser help systems. At the end of this course, you will be able to quickly and easily implement the information you learned into your own publishing environment.

#### **What are the prerequisites?**

This course assumes no prior knowledge of WebWorks.

You should have familiarity with FrameMaker objects such as paragraph styles, tables, markers and cross references. A knowledge of mark-up languages such as HTML and XHTML will be useful. You need to be familiar with PCs and the Windows environment.
